

ADHESIVE SUTURE RETENTION DEVICE


How to Apply ASRD



Completely clean and dry skin around wound

Adhere ASRDs 1cm from skin edge; place full thickness suture through device and tighten as necessary to offload wound tension





Choose desired finishing closure technique with sutures, staples, and/or glue

Designed to Prevent **Dehiscence**

Compared to sutures alone, ASRD supported suture closures resulted in:*

- 80% reduced dehiscence
- 25% increased perfusion
- Earlier weightbearing
- Faster incisional healing
- Reduced skin tearing and blistering
- Reduced undermining, dermal sutures and second intent healing



Common Tension Offloading Applications





















ZONAL® Technology

Engineered to offload tension, maintain proper perfusion levels, and minimize wound complications




ZONAL® Stiffness
